- (a) Whether the Government has any plan to introduce new Board for vedic studies;
- (b) If so, the necessary steps taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (c) by when the Government is planning to introduce it?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c): The Central Government has only two School Boards namely Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS). However, Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Ved Vidya Pratisthan (MSRVVP), Ujjain, an autonomous body under the Ministry of Education, has given permission for a private Board for blended education including both vedic studies and modern subjects. Maharshi Rashtriya Ved Vidya Pratisthan (MSRVVP), Ujjain is also considering setting up another Board for oral vedic traditions with modern subjects.
