“Setting up of AIIMS Hospital in Khajuraho”

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is considering to establish a new AIIMS or any other institute like AIIMS in Khajuraho for serving 80 lakh people facing shortage of medical services in under developed region of Bundelkhand;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

a) to (c) The Government of India has plans to establish AIIMS in all the States in the country in a phased manner under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY). As far as Madhya Pradesh is concerned, one AIIMS at Bhopal has already been established and it is functional. There is no proposal under consideration of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare to establish a new AIIMS or an Institute like AIIMS in Khajuraho.
