Development of Public Enterprises in West Bengal

2077: SHRI SUNIL KUMAR MONDAL:

Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of various schemes launched for the development of public enterprises in West Bengal and in various other States of the country during the last six years;
- (b) whether any new scheme is to be introduced in near future;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the details of funds sanctioned for the development of the public enterprise in the budgetary allocation 2020 and percentage of funds released/ expended to West Bengal during Covid-19 pandemic and till date?

(a) to (d): Department of Public Enterprises is implementing the following schemes:

- i) Research, Development and Consultancy (RDC) scheme which seeks to enhance capacity of officials of CPSEs through training, etc. and
- ii) Counselling, Retraining & Re-deployment (CRR) Scheme to enable Voluntary Retirement Scheme (VRS)/ Voluntary Separation Scheme (VSS) optees or their dependents to engage themselves in alternate vocations of self-employment/wage employment through re-skilling.

No state-wise allocation is made under these schemes. During the year 2020-21 a sum of Rs 3.70 Crore was spent under the schemes. No new scheme are proposed to be introduced.
