Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) the reasons for continually high LPG prices, even as international prices fell;

(b) the details of the variation in gas cylinder prices, subsidised and non-subsidised over the last five years, State-wise;

(c) the number of initial beneficiaries of the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) who have sought cylinder refills, State/year-wise;

(d) the number of initial beneficiaries of the PMUY who have sought at least three cylinder refills, State-wise;

(e) the number of people using LPG as the primary or exclusive fuel, year-wise along with the measures being taken to ensure LPG usage beyond first-use; and

(f) whether the Government has an understanding of the impact of increasing LPG prices on overall household expenditure?

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a): The prices of petroleum products in the country are linked to the price of respective products in the international market. Prices of LPG in the country are based on Saudi Contract Price (CP), the benchmark for international prices of LPG and during October, 2020 to April,

2021 Saudi CP has risen from 359 USD to 607 USD. India imports more than 55 % of its LPG requirement.

(b): The details of average prices of domestic LPG cylinders (14.2 kg) at Delhi market during the last five years and the current year is given as under:

(c): The State-wise number of PMUY Beneficiaries taken LPG refills during the last two financial years and the current year (Apr-Jun'21) is provided at **Annexure-1**.

(d): The State-wise number of initial PMUY beneficiaries who have taken at least three refills as on 31.05.2021 since inception of the scheme is provided at **Annexure-2**.

(e): As on 01.07.2021, there are 29.11 crore active Domestic LPG consumers (including PMUY Customers) on all India basis. Year-wise numbers of Active Domestic customers (incl. PMUY Customers) during last three years are given below:

The various steps being taken to improve LPG consumption among PMUY beneficiaries is given below:

- Deferment of loan recovery from subsidy amount to reduce the net cash outgo of a PMUY consumer to encourage refill consumption for six refills or period of one year whichever is earlier during FY 18-19 and also during Aug '19 – July '20.
- Swap option from 14.2 kg connections to 5 kg connections which will reduce the upfront cash outgo for a PMUY consumer and thus encourage refill consumption.
- PMUY connections were given option of 5kg DBC package for the financial ease of the customer. To avail the 5kg refills, the upfront cash outgo for a customer will be low.
- During lockdown on account of Covid-19, existing PMUY beneficiaries were supported with free refills scheme under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana. Under this scheme, an advance was given to the linked bank account of the beneficiaries using which refills could be availed.
- Conducting Pradhan Mantri LPG Panchayat (PMLP), a community-based program to create awareness about the scheme and also to address any issue pertaining to LPG usage.
- After achieving 8 Crore LPG connections, PMLP targeted nil or low refill consumers, to convince them about sustained usage of LPG. Total 1.46 lakh LPG Panchayats were conducted during 2018-20.

(f): In order to insulate the common man from the impact of rise in international oil prices, the Government continues to modulate the effective price to consumer of Domestic LPG. The prices of non-subsidized Domestic LPG are however determined by the OMCs in line with changes in the international markets. Government provided upto 3 free of cost LPG cylinder refills to PMUY consumers in the year 2020 to provide support during COVID pandemic. The impact of increase in prices of LPG can be seen on inflationary trend measured by Wholesale Price Index (WPI). The weightage of LPG in the WPI index is 0.64%.
