FUNDS TO HARYANA UNDER VARIOUS SCHEMES

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the funds allocated to Haryana under various schemes during the last three years and the current year;

(b) the details of the funds spent during the said period;

(c) whether the Government has constituted any committee to monitor these centres so that the students may became job-worthy after completing the course from these centre and if so, the details thereof; and

(d) the number of the persons who have been employed under Skill development and Entrepreneurship scheme during the last three years district-wise of Haryana State?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

(a) Details of fund released to Haryana under various schemes of this Ministry namely; Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Skill Strengthening for Industrial Value Enhancement (STRIVE), Skills Acquisition and Knowledge Awareness for Livelihood Promotion (SANKALP), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS), Upgradation of existing Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) into Model ITIs; during last three years and current year are at **Annexure-I.**

(b) The funds utilised by the State of Haryana during this period is at **Annexure-II.**

(c) Under the flagship scheme Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), a Monitoring Committee has been constituted to ensure that the students may became jobworthy after completing the course from the empaneled training centres. Under PMKVY, various processes have been adopted across the training lifecycle to ensure enrolled candidates receive quality training and placement in compliance to the scheme guidelines. These include attendance monitoring through Aadhaar enabled biometric attendance system, candidate verifications through calls, surprise centre visits, virtual verification of training centres, and outcome based financial pay-outs to training centres. The findings through the monitoring mechanisms are further submitted to the Monitoring Committee for due diligence. In case of non-compliance, the training centre is penalized in accordance to the devised penalty matrix.

(d) Under PMKVY, placement opportunities are being provided to candidates certified under Short Term Training (STT). Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) does not mandate placement as it orients and certifies candidate with prior learning experience or skills. In the last three years (FY 2018-21), 1.07 lakh candidates have been placed in the state of Haryana. The district wise details are given in **Annexure-III.**
