**DISPUTE BETWEEN ANDHRA PRADESH AND KARNATAKA  
OVER BIRTH PLACE OF HANUMAN**

2203. SHRI SANGANNA AMARAPPA:

Will the Minister of Culture be pleased to state:

- (a) whether recently there was a clash between Andhra based TTD Board and Karnataka State about the Birthplace of Hanuman and was in discussion in all medias. TTD claims that Hanuman was born in one of the Seven Hills of Tirupati and is about to submit a report, whereas Karnataka had displayed documentary evidences to prove Hanuman was born in Anjanadri situated in Koppal District;
- (b) whether this matter has come to the notice of the Union Government;
- (c) if so, the measures which the Government has taken to investigate the fact;
- (d) if not, steps taken to direct the ASI to inspect and submit a detailed report about birthplace of Hanuman; and
- (e) the action taken to declare the actual birthplace of Hanuman at the earliest to avoid further clashes between the neighbouring States?
