Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपओक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government intends to install Point of Sale (PoS) machines at fair price shops;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the total number of fair price shops in the country, State-wise including Madhya Pradesh;
- (d) whether the Government plans to set-up more fair price shops and construct FCI godowns in the country during forth coming years; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

- (a) & (b): Under the Public Distribution System (PDS) reforms, so far, the electronic Point of Sale (ePoS) devices are operational in about 4.98 Lakh (92.7%) Fair Price Shops (FPSs) out of nearly 5.38 Lakh FPSs across the country.
- (c): A statement showing State/UT wise number of FPSs, including Madhya Pradesh and total FPSs in the country is at Annexure.
- (d) & (e): The Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) under National Food Security Act, 2013 (NFSA) is operated in joint responsibilities of the Central and State/UT Governments, wherein inter-alia the operational responsibilities of, licensing of FPSs, deciding the number of FPSs, continuous monitoring and oversight of all FPS operations, etc. rests with the concerned State/UT government.

Yes, for construction of FCI Godowns. Government has taken the steps to augment the storage capacity under the extended Central Sector Scheme (2017-2022) totaling to 1,05,890 MT and 59,560 MT capacity for North East States and other than North East States respectively.
