- (a) the details of the additional borrowing done by States for implementing the One Nation One Ration Card reform (ONORC), State-wise and year-wise;
- (b) the status of Aadhar seeding, in terms of percentage and in absolute numbers of beneficiaries for completing the ONORC reform, the details thereof, Statewise;
- (c) the measures being undertaken by the Government to rope in the States who are yet to adopt the reform; and
- (d) the estimated number of beneficiaries who are using the portable option of the ONORC reform since the launch including the number of such transactions which are inter-State, the details thereof State-wise and monthwise and the total number who are intra-state among them?

(b): As per reports received upto 09<sup>th</sup> July 2021, nearly 21.92 Crore (92.8%) of total 23.63 Crore ration cards have been Aadhaar seeded at the national level. A State/UT wise statement showing percentage and in absolute numbers is at Annexure-I.

(c): Regular follow up has been done with 4 remaining States/UT of Assam, Chhattisgarh, Delhi and West Bengal through Video Conferencing, review meetings, central technical support from NIC, letters and DO from all levels to enable the ONORC plan for the benefit of migrant beneficiaries.

(d): A Statement showing State/UT wise and Month-wise inter-State and intra-State portability transactions since inception of ONORC plan in August 2019 is at Annexure-II.
