**2563.        SHRIMATI MALA ROY:**

**Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether foreign diplomats posted in India received COVID screening;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the extent of coverage of fully vaccinated foreign diplomats currently in India, along with the number and percentage thereof; and
- (d) the details of places from where these vaccine were sourced from?

(a) to (d) As a public health measure, it was decided to offer vaccinations to foreign personnel of Embassies, Consulates, United Nations offices and their specialized agencies and other international organizations located in India.

A total of 3751 such foreign personnel registered with the Ministry of External Affairs for COVID19 vaccination as per details below:
