- (a) whether a National Rail Plan (NRP) for infrastructure development and privatisation of Railways for thirty years has been evolved; and
- (b) if so, the timeline for privatisation of passenger trains, freight trains, stations, production units, railway public sector like CONCOR, Dedicated Freight Corridor corporation, etc. as per NRP?
