(a) the main features of bio-toilets developed by the Defence Research and Development Organisaton(DRDO);

(b) whether the DRDO is using cowdung in the said bio-toilets;

(c) if so, the details thereof; and

(d) the number of bio-toilets constructed so far, State-wise including district Satna along with the number of people benefited so far?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI AJAY BHATT)

(a) The major features of bio-toilet developed by Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) are as under:

- (i) It makes use of an anaerobic (without oxygen) process through which the human waste is digested by a consortium of bacteria
- (ii) Bio-toilet has been customized and different designs have been developed for use under different geo-climatic conditions.

(b) & (c): Yes, Sir. The Cow dung is used for the enrichment bacterial consortium. Following four types of bacteria are present in the consortium:

- (i) Hydrolase
- (ii) Acidogenase
- (iii) Acitogenase
- (iv) Methogens

(d) State wise details of bio-toilets constructed are attached as Annexure.

However, till date no bio-toilet has been constructed in District Satna.

Total 16507 bio-digesters have been installed in different states. Bio-digesters have many variants as per the number of users and considering the design for 5-7 users, atleast 80000-112000 people have been benefitted by these bio-toilets.
