(a) to (c): Railway projects are sanctioned Zonal Railway wise and not State wise as Indian Railway's network span across various State boundaries. However, during the last five Budgets i.e. 2017-18 to 2021-22, seven new line projects for a length of 509 km falling fully/partly in Maharashtra have been included in Budget subject to requisite Government approvals. The details and status of these projects are as under:

(d) to (f): The completion of any Railway project depends on various factors like, quick land acquisition by State Government, forest clearance by officials of forest department, shifting of infringing utilities, statutory clearances from various authorities, geological and topographical conditions of area, law and order situation in the area of project site, number of working months in a year for particular project site due to climatic conditions, orders of Hon'ble Courts, encountering unforeseen conditions like earthquake, flooding, pandemic etc. All these factors affect the completion time of the project(s). Hence, no confirmed time frame for completion of project(s) can be ascertained at this stage.
