Price Chain of Bamboo Based Products

†2766. SHRI BALAK NATH:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any scheme is being implemented by the Government in Rajasthan State for the development of price chain of the bamboo based products;
- (b) if so, the details of the provisions for the entrepreneurs for setting up the small and medium processing units under this scheme; and
- (c) the details of total number of small and medium processing units set up in the country including Rajasthan so far after the restructuring of NBM, State/district-wise?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Government is implementing the restructured **National Bamboo Mission (NBM)** from the year 2018-19. NBM focuses on the development of complete value chain of bamboo sector to link growers with consumers starting from planting material, creation of facilities for collection, aggregation, processing, marketing, skill development and brand building initiative in a cluster approach mode.

The scheme is being implemented in the States where it has social, commercial and economical advantage, including the bamboo rich States of North Eastern region and in Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Karnataka, Uttarakhand, Bihar, Jharkhand, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Gujarat, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Uttar Pradesh & Himachal Pradesh. Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir is also included under NBM in the year 2020-21.

The restructured National Bamboo Mission (NBM) is not being implemented in the State of Rajasthan.

In addition, the Ministry of MSME is implementing Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) across the country including Rajasthan to promote rural entrepreneurship. PMEGP is a major credit-linked subsidy programme aimed at generating self-employment opportunities through establishment of micro-enterprises in the non-farm sector including the cane and bamboo based micro units by helping traditional artisans and rural/urban unemployed youth. Maximum cost of the project under the scheme in manufacturing sector is Rs. 25.00 Lakh and in service Sector Rs. 10.00 Lakh. Margin Money subsidy payable by the Government varies from 15% to 35% for different categories.

(c): The total number of MSME units established across the country under the NBM (as on 30.06.2021) is given in Annexure.
