Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is considering to formulate additional schemes for densely populated districts of rural areas in order to resolve the water problems;
- (b) if so, whether it is being considered for Uttar Pradesh also; and
- (c) if so, the whether it is being considered to formulate any central scheme to provide water connectivity for the rural population of Firozabad district?

(a) to (c) To enable every rural household, including those in rural areas of Uttar Pradesh inter alia which include Firozabad and densely populated districts across the country, to have potable tap water supply in adequate quantity, of prescribed quality and on regular and long-term basis, Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal. The estimated outlay of the Mission is Rs. 3.60 lakh Crore, out of which Central share is Rs. 2.08 lakh Crore.
