**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the funds released to Punjab and Rajasthan for the vision of Housing for All;**
- (b) the number of persons benefitted under the said scheme in Punjab and Rajasthan as on date, district-wise;**
- (c) the details of the total number of houses sanctioned, allotted and still under construction in the State of Punjab and Rajasthan during the last two years; and**
- (d) whether there has been delay in construction and allotment of houses under this scheme due to COVID-19 and if so, the details thereof along with the steps taken by the Government to address the same?**

- (a): Central Assistance of ₹1,061.62 crore for Punjab and ₹2,298.79 crore for Rajasthan has been released so far under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U) for the vision of Housing for All.**
- (b): The district-wise details of number of persons benefitted so far in Punjab and Rajasthan under PMAY-U, are at Annexure-I.**
- (c): The details of total number of houses sanctioned, allotted and still under construction in the State of Punjab and Rajasthan during the last two years under PMAY-U are at Annexure-II.**
- (d): Yes, Sir. Works were stopped due to lockdown in view of the Covid-19 pandemic that has delayed the completion of projects. However, after opening up, projects picked up.**
