HOUSING FOR ALL SCHEME IN PUNJAB AND RAJASTHAN

NO. 2804. SHRI BHAGWANT MANN:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds released to Punjab and Rajasthan for the vision of Housing for All;
- (b) the number of persons benefitted under the said scheme in Punjab and Rajasthan as on date, district-wise;
- (c) the details of the total number of houses sanctioned, allotted and still under construction in the State of Punjab and Rajasthan during the last two years; and
- (d) whether there has been delay in construction and allotment of houses under this scheme due to COVID-19 and if so, the details thereof along with the steps taken by the Government to address the same?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

- (a): Central Assistance of ₹1,061.62 crore for Punjab and ₹2,298.79 crore for Rajasthan has been released so far under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Urban (PMAY-U) for the vision of Housing for All.
- (b): The district-wise details of number of persons benefitted so far in Punjab and Rajasthan under PMAY-U, are at Annexure-I.
- (c): The details of total number of houses sanctioned, allotted and still under construction in the State of Punjab and Rajasthan during the last two years under PMAY-U are at Annexure-II.
- (d): Yes, Sir. Works were stopped due to lockdown in view of the Covid-19 pandemic that has delayed the completion of projects. However, after opening up, projects picked up.
