WATER RECYCLING PLANTS

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any provision to recycle water under the drinking water schemes in Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the water recycling plants set up in the rural areas of Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra?

ANSWER

(a) to (b) Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) in partnership with States to make provision of potable tap water supply to every rural household in the country, by 2024. Further, under Swachh Bharat Mission–Gramin (SBM–G) Phase-II, which is also under implementation, provisions have been made for the management of grey water generated in villages.

The grey water treatment and its reuse is an important component, while planning for rural drinking water schemes under the Jal Jeevan Mission. Under Jal Jeevan Mission, provision has been made for the preparation of Village Action Plan (VAP) by local village community, inter alia which includes treatment and reuse of grey water in convergence with other schemes such as MGNREGS, 15th Finance Commission tied grants to rural local bodies/ PRIs for water & sanitation, SBM (G), District Mineral Development Fund, CSR fund, community contribution, etc.

(c) As such, details of plants for recycling of water, are not maintained in this Department.
