- (d) the funds allocated, released and utilised thereon till date; and**
- (e) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?**

(a) to (c) The development of this stretch has been envisaged in the category of National Corridor (East-West Corridor) in Bharatmala Pariyojana. The Land Acquisition Committee of NHAI has approved the alignment. The project is targeted for award in the current Financial Year with tentative cost of Rs. 1,572.69 Crores.

(d) & (e) Does not arise as the work has not been awarded.
