- (d) whether there is any financial crunch for development of such projects in the State and if so, the details thereof?**

(a) The details are as under:

2021-22	13	561.17
2022-23	15	702.85
Beyond 2022-23	19	880.87

(b) The details of highway length constructed in the State of Karnataka during last three years are as under:

Year	Length completed (in Km)
2018-19	779
2019-20	500
2020-21	425

(c) Two Projects (i) 4-laning of Bellary - Byrapura section of NH-150A (Package-I) (ii) 4/6 laning of Hospet – Bellary – Karnataka / AP Border of NH-63.

(d) There is no financial crunch. However, one project i.e. 4-laning of Hospet –Bellary Section is delayed due to financial issues of the Contractor. Relief under Atmanirbhar Scheme has been extended to the Contractor and the present physical progress is 52.74%.
