Development of MSMEs Cluster

2898. SHRI SANJAY KAKA PATIL:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes a new project on Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs);
- (b) whether the Government proposes to establish a new hub or industrial parks for MSMEs;
- (c) whether the Government is considering to develop MSMEs cluster in Maharashtra State; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Ministry of MSME implements Micro and Small Enterprises – Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP). Under the scheme, financial support is extended to projects of the State Government to create / upgrade Infrastructural facilities in new / existing industrial estates / industrial areas. Under “Scheme of Funds for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI)”, traditional industry artisans are organised in clusters by providing technology support, marketing support & skill development.

(c): Ministry of MSME through its schemes namely “Micro and Small Enterprises - Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP)” and “Scheme of Funds for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI)” establishes Common Facility Centers (CFCs) in the clusters for development of Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) across the country including Maharashtra.

(d): Under MSE-CDP and SFURTI, 47 nos. Common Facility Center projects have been approved for development of clusters in Maharashtra, The details of CFCs are as under:
