(a) to (c) The Detailed Project Report (DPR) work of about 14 km Northern Agra Bypass has been initiated, which starts at NH-2 and ends at Yamuna Expressway. It is targeted for award in the Year 2021-22 and completion by Year 2024-25 with tentative cost of Rs. 523 crore. The 3A Gazette Notification has also been published on 09.04.2021. This bypass has been conceptualised to decongest and improve road connectivity in and around Agra City.
