## CIVILIAN FLIGHT ON BIO FUEL

## 2960. SHRI T.R. PAARIVENDHAR

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION नागर विमानन मंत्री

be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government has operated or proposes to operate any civilian flight on bio-fuel;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the total number of such flights being operated on bio-fuel;
- (d) if not, whether the Government will consider to operate the flights on biofuel due to heavy rise in the fuel price and to reduce the cost of flight operation;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?

## ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION नागर विमानन मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))

- (a) to (c) The Government has not operated any civilian flight on bio-fuel till date. However, Spicejet, a private Indian carrier had conducted a demonstration flight with Bombardier Q400 aircraft in August 2018 using bio-fuel blended with Aviation Turbine Fuel (ATF) (in the ratio of 25:75) in one engine.
- (d) to (f) At present, the price of bio-fuels is higher than that of ATF due to very limited production. Hence, at this stage, operations using bio-fuels does not result in reduced operation costs.
