IMPLEMENTATION OF JJM IN WEST BENGAL

2966. MS. LOCKET CHATTERJEE:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the State Government is cooperating with the Union Government for the implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM);
- (b) the details of the funds allocated to West Bengal under this mission since its inception;
- (c) whether West Bengal is at the last position in the country in providing piped drinking water to all households;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) whether the Government of West Bengal has changed the name of Jal Jeevan Mission to Jal Swapno in West Bengal?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

- (a) Since August, 2019, Government of India in partnership with States, including West Bengal, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) to make provision of tap water connection to every rural household by 2024.
- (b) The details of fund allocated, released and reported utilization in West Bengal under JJM in 2019-20, 2020-21 & 2021-22, is as under:

(c) & (d) At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission in August, 2019, out of total 163.26 lakh rural households in West Bengal, only 2.14 lakh (1.21%) households were reported to have tap water connections. Since then, another 16.55 lakh [9.34%] households have been provided tap water connections. Thus, as on date, out of 177.23 Lakh rural households in the State, 18.70 lakh (10.55%) households have tap water supply in their homes. West Bengal has planned to make provision of tap water supply to every rural home by 2024.
