(a) & (b) The work of Bhavenagar- Somnath National Highway (NH) project was sanctioned in 2016 with completion period of 30 months. The stretch was split into 6 construction packages. The physical progress of these packages are as under:

- (c) The work has been delayed due to various reasons such as land acquisition, financial issues with concessionaires and COVID pandemic etc.
- (d) The works of packages-II & III were terminated and re-awarded on EPC mode to complete balance work.
