Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers are receiving additional incentives for the additional COVID related tasks carried out by them;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether her Ministry has received complaints regarding violence against Anganwadi workers during the pandemic;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken thereon;
- (e) whether a significant number of vacancies for Child Development Project Officers (CDPO) and Anganwadi Lady Supervisors are lying vacant across the country; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the measures initiated to fill the backlog of vacancies, Statewise?

ANSWER

MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) & (b) As Anganwadi Services is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme, which is implemented by States/UTs. Government has issued directions to all States/UTs to make all possible arrangements for providing safety equipment like masks and sanitizers etc. to Anganwadi Workers, Anganwadi Helpers and ASHAs in the COVID-19 pandemic situation. Also, Anganwadi Centres are closed due to Covid-19 pandemic so as to control the spread of virus.

Further, the Government has enhanced the honorarium w.e.f. 01.10.2018 to Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) from ₹ 3,000/- to ₹ 4,500/- per month; AWWs at mini-AWCs from ₹ 2,250/- to ₹ 3,500/- per month; Anganwadi Helpers (AWHs) from ₹ 1,500/- to ₹ 2,250/- per month; and introduced performance linked incentive to AWHs @ ₹ 250/- per month.

Apart from the honorarium and other incentives paid by the Government of India, respective State/UTs are also giving monetary incentives to these workers. Various State Governments are compensating these AWWs/ AWHs out of their own resources for COVID related activities.

- (c) & (d) No State has reported any such incident to this Ministry. However, it is the duty of the State administrations to ensure safety and security of AWWs/ AWHs.
- (e) & (f) The State/UT-wise details of positions sanctioned, in-position and vacant with respect to CDPOs and Supervisors is placed at **Annexure I**.

From time to time, States/UTs are advised to fill the sanctioned positions of staff which are lying vacant for effective implementation of the Scheme. Further, directions/advisory has been sent to States/UTs to recruit the personnel on contract basis till such time the vacancies are filled on regular basis.
