Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received a number of proposals from State Government of Karnataka for setting up of trauma care centres and up gradation/ modernization of medical colleges;
- (b) if so, the details thereof during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (c) the progress made on such proposals by the Government along with the funds released for the purpose during the said period, proposal- wise; and
- (d) the number of said proposals pending for approval with the Government along with the necessary steps taken in this regard?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

- (a) to (c): During 11th Five Year Plan (2007-2012) under "National Programme for Prevention and Management of Trauma and Burn Injuries" proposals were received from State Government of Karnataka and eight hospitals/medical colleges were approved for setting up of trauma care facilities. All the eight trauma care facilities are reported to be functional by State Government. Details of fund released facilities wise attached at Annexure-I.
- (d) In view of above reply, does not arise.
