Shortage of COVID-19 Medicines

304. SHRIMATI MALA ROY:

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) the details about the total number of COVID-19 treatment related medicine supply to State Governments from 1st January 2021 to 30th June 2021, State/UT-wise; and(b) whether there has been any shortage of supply, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS (SHRI MANSUKH MANDAVIYA)

(a): The monitoring of availability of COVID-19 related drugs started w.e.f. first week of April, 2021 when the COVID-19 cases in the country started rising very fast leading to temporary shortages of some drugs. Department of Pharmaceuticals, in consultation with Department of Health and Family Welfare, started allocating such drugs to States/UTs where a temporary mismatch in demand and supply was observed in order to ensure equitable availability of such drugs across all regions of the country. Allocation was done for following four drugs: Remdesivir, Tocilizumab, Amphotericin B (Liposomal) and Amphotericin B (Conventional). Allocation of Remdesivir started on 21.4.2021, Tocilizumab on 30.4.2021, Amphotericin B-Liposomal on 11.5.2021, and Amphotericin B – Conventional on 14.6.2021 respectively. The details of supply of the allocated drugs to States/UTs up to 30th June, 2021 is given in Table below: -

(b): Addressing the issues of shortage of drugs across the country is a regular activity of National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority (NPPA). NPPA received 1011 complaints on shortage of drugs on its Helpline during second wave of COVID-19. NPPA made efforts to ensure the availability of the above drugs in all the States/UTs by coordinating with the manufacturers and nodal officers of SDCs based on the allocations made by DoP to various States/UTs.

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
