- (c) whether the construction of houses under Swadhar scheme has been stopped in some States particularly in Uttar Pradesh due to non release of funds by the Union Government; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor?

- (a) and (b) Yes Sir, the Government has launched the Swadhar Greh scheme to support women victims of difficult circumstances in need of institutional support for rehabilitation. The Scheme envisages providing shelter, food, clothing and health as well as economic and social security for the women victims of difficult circumstances. As on 31.03.2021, Swadhar Greh Scheme has been implemented in 30 States/UTs. The details of number of Swadhar Greh and beneficiaries under the Swadhar Greh Scheme since inception is at Annexure I.
- (c) The construction of houses under Swadhar scheme has not been stopped in States particularly in Uttar Pradesh due to non release of funds by the Union Government.
