- (a) to (c) The Department has been implementing following dairy development schemes to promote dairy development across the country :-
  - (i) Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organizations engaged in dairy activities (SDCFPO)
  - (ii) National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD)
  - (iii) Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund (DIDF)

The details of the above Schemes are given at **Annexure.**

S. No.	Scheme	Details of Schemes
1.	<b>Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organizations engaged in dairy activities (SDCFPO)</b>	<p>This scheme launched during 2017-18, is implemented by National Dairy Development Board with the objective of assisting the Cooperative Societies and Farmer Producer Organizations engaged in dairy activities by providing soft working capital loan to tide over the crisis on account of severely adverse market conditions or natural calamities. Due to Economic Impact of Covid-19 on Dairy Sector, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying has introduced a new component “<b>interest subvention on Working capital loans for Dairy sector</b>” as one of the component with an outlay of Rs 203 Crore for 2020-21. Temporarily, the other component namely “working Capital loan” was kept in suspension during 2020-21.</p> <p>As on 02.07.2021, National Dairy Development Board (NDDB) have conveyed sanction of Interest Subvention amount of Rs 150.58 crore against working capital loan amount of Rs 10588.64 Crore @ 2% per annum (p.a) and released Rs 71.63 Crore as interest subvention amount.</p>
2.	<b>National Programme for Dairy Development(NPDD)</b>	<p>The Department is implementing National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD) scheme since Feb-2014 with an objective of creating/strengthening of infrastructure for Production of quality milk, Procurement, Processing and Marketing of Milk &amp; Milk Products by the State Implementing Agency (SIA) i.e. State Cooperative Dairy Federations/ District Cooperative Milk Producers’ Union.</p> <p>An amount of Rs 1191.42 crore has been released to 30 States/UTs under NPDD till 30.06.2021.</p>
3.	<b>Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund (DIDF)</b>	<p>The Scheme is implemented with objective of Creation/strengthening of Milk Processing, Value addition &amp; chilling facilities with total outlay of Rs. 11,184 crore. Under the Scheme National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) disburses loan to National Dairy Development Board (NDDB)/ National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) .National Dairy Development Board (NDDB)/ National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) thereafter disburses loan to the eligible End Borrowers. Government of India (GOI) provides 2.5% interest subvention under the Scheme.</p> <p>As on 31.05.2021, 40 projects in 11 states have been approved with total outlay of Rs 4957 Crore and loan component of Rs. 3381 Crore. Loan of amount Rs.1157Crore has been disbursed to End Borrowers. Interest subvention released is Rs. 54.59 Crore.</p>
