### "AUGMENTED AND VIRTUAL REALITY TECHNOLOGY"

#### 3078 SHRI T.R.V.S. RAMESH:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to implement Virtual reality (VR) and augmented reality (AR) technologies in various medical institutions in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the manner in which the said technology is going to be beneficial in better understanding the practical concepts of learning for the medical students; and
- (d) the number of government and affiliated medical intuitions that are in existence in the country, State/UT-wise?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

- (a) to (c): Minimum Requirements for Annual M.B.B.S. Admissions Regulations, 2020 of National Medical Commission (NMC) provides for that every medical institution shall have a Skills Laboratory where students can practice and improve skills pre-specified in the competency based undergraduate curriculum. The skills laboratory attempts to recreate the clinical environment and tasks which future health care workers have to perform with various levels of complexity and fidelity. As per information provided by the NMC, Virtual Reality (VR) and Augmented Reality (AR) technologies are used in few medical institutions in India. These technologies are for teaching medical students and help them learn to treat the patients or perform surgeries in a virtual environment.
- (d): There are 289 Government and 269 private medical colleges / institutions in the country. The State/ UT wise list of Government and private medical colleges / institutions is attached at Annexure.
