(a) to (c): The Government does not have any proposal as of now, to establish Textile Excellence Centres in the country, including Maharashtra. However, under the Technology Mission for Technical Textiles, Government has extended financial support towards creation of infrastructure of eight (8) Centers of Excellences (CoEs) in various textile research and academic organizations. The details of these organizations and the amount of funding are given below:-
