Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is contemplating to upgrade/ modernise Government hospitals particularly in rural areas of the country including Maharashtra and Jharkhand:
- (b) if so, the details of Government hospitals upgraded/ modernised during the last three years in Maharashtra, district wise, hospital wise; and
- (c) the funds allocated/proposed to be allocated for the same and their actual utilisation during the last three years and the current year?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) Public Health and Hospitals being a State Subject, the primary responsibility for strengthening health care systems, including theupgradation / modernization of hospitals, lies with the respective State/UT Governments. However, under National Health Mission, Government of India provides financial and technical support to States/UTs to strengthen their healthcare systemsspecially in rural areas,for the expansion/ modernization/upgradation of infrastructure,uptothe level of District Hospitals,in all states/UTs including Maharashtra and Jharkhand.

Under Ayushman Bharat, 1.5 lakhs Health & Wellness Centers (HWCs) are being set up, especially in villages and remote areas, by upgrading Sub-Health

Centers(SHC's) & Primary Health Centers (PHC's) for delivering comprehensive primary health care, closer to the homes of the people. More than 77791 SHCs and PHCs have been transformed as AB-HWCs so far all over the country.
