Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is contemplating to upgrade/ modernise Government hospitals particularly in rural areas of the country including Maharashtra and Jharkhand;
- (b) if so, the details of Government hospitals upgraded/ modernised during the last three years in Maharashtra, district wise, hospital wise; and
- (c) the funds allocated/proposed to be allocated for the same and their actual utilisation during the last three years and the current year?

(a) Public Health and Hospitals being a State Subject, the primary responsibility for strengthening health care systems, including the upgradation / modernization of hospitals, lies with the respective State/UT Governments. However, under National Health Mission, Government of India provides financial and technical support to States/UTs to strengthen their healthcare systems especially in rural areas, for the expansion/ modernization/upgradation of infrastructure, upto the level of District Hospitals, in all states/UTs including Maharashtra and Jharkhand.

Under Ayushman Bharat, 1.5 lakhs Health & Wellness Centers (HWCs) are being set up, especially in villages and remote areas, by upgrading Sub-Health

Centers(SHC's) &Primary Health Centers (PHC's) for delivering comprehensive primary health care, closer to the homes of the people. More than 77791 SHCs and PHCs have been transformed as AB-HWCs so far all over the country.
