MEDICAL OFFICERS IN PARA-MILITARY FORCES

328. ADV. A.M. ARIFF:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken any steps for recruiting to the posts of Specialist Medical Officers and Medical Officers in Central Para-Military Forces, namely, Central Reserve Police Force, Border Security Force, Assam Rifles, Sashastra Seema Bal and Indo-Tibetan Border Police.
- (b) if so, the details of the un-filled vacancies in the above category as on 15th February 2021 force-wise; and
- (c) whether the Government will take any steps to expedite the recruitment process by appointing candidates from reserve rank list of candidates before its expiry?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

(a) & (b): Recruitment of Specialist and General Duty Medical Officers in Central Armed Police Forces & Assam Rifles is being made regularly through Medical Officers Selection Board (MOSB).

The force-wise details of the un-filled vacancies of Specialist Medical Officers (Spl. MO) and General Duty Medical Officers (GDMOs) as on 15th February, 2021 is as under:-

Further, in the wake of Covid-19 pandemic, CRPF has been allowed to recruit General Duty Medical Officers (GDMOs) on contract basis against vacant posts of Specialists Medical Officers for a period of one year.

(c): Offers have already been given to the candidates in the reserve list of last MOSB and many candidates have joined against the vacant posts.
