3292. SHRI S. JAGATHRAKSHAKAN:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether it is true that no instructional technology has been developed to replace cooperative learning that takes place in group projects, fields studies, recitals and presentations:
- (b) If so, the details thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) Whether the Government has drawn any action plan to achieve National Education Policy's objective of enhancing the gross enrolment rate in higher education in the country from the current 26 per cent to 50 per cent by 2035; and
- (d) If so, the details thereof?

ANSWER MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

- (a) No, Sir.
- (b) Instructional technology tools are available to promote cooperative learning. The tools such as padlet, flipgrid, Google Forums to promote cooperative learning have been adopted. More than 25000 faculty members enhanced their skill set in deploying such tools into their classroom teaching through the training program.
- (c) & (d) Yes, Sir. The Government has taken the following actions: -
