Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to provide free International English Language Testing System/Occupational English Test (IELTS/OET) training to professional candidates including nurses, seeking employment abroad;

In addition, one day Pre-Departure Orientation Training (PDOT) is imparted to migrant workers by NSDC under Pravasi Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PKVY).
