WASTAGE OF FOOD GRAIN

334. SHRI SUDHAKAR TUKARAM SHRANGARE: (**OIH**)

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether according to an estimate food products worth Rs. 92,600 crores got exterminated every year during the harvesting of major crops and after that similarly loss pertaining to fruits and vegetables is of around Rs. 40,800 crores;
- (b) if so, the budget allocated by the Government during the years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020,2021 for preconditioning, pre-cooling, processing of fruits and vegetables, packing and labelling facility cold chain for the storage of perishable fruits and vegetables and to develop rapid transportation system and the funds spent thereon; and
- (c) the details thereof, State-wise including Maharashtra?

(a) : As per a study conducted by ICAR-CIPHET, Ludhiana on the extent of harvest and post-harvest losses of major agricultural produce in 2015, the estimated annual value of harvest and post-harvest losses of major agricultural produce at national level was Rs. 92,651 crore using production data of 2012-13 at 2014 wholesale prices. Similarly, the estimated loss for fruits was Rs. 16,644 crores and for vegetables was Rs.14,842 crores.

(b) & (c): In order to minimize the post-harvest losses and enhance value addition in agricultural produce, Ministry of Food Processing Industries has been implementing the Scheme for Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure since 2008. The Scheme provides for promoting integrated cold chain facilities from the farm gate to the consumer, end to end, in order to reduce losses by improving efficiency in the collection of farm produce, its storage, transportation and minimal processing. Both horticultural and non-horticultural produce are eligible for support under this scheme.

Year-wise budget allocation and expenditure under the scheme is as follows:
