409. MS. DIYA KUMARI:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of women skilled under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDUGKY) in Rajasthan, district-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to undertake measures to ensure inclusive and equitable skilling across genders; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) The District-wise number of women skilled under the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) in Rajasthan is given at **Annexure**.
- (b) & (c): Yes, an inclusive approach towards skilling across genders has been adhered to. DDU-GKY guidelines provide that minimum one third of the persons covered under DDU-GKY should be women. This is being adhered to and presently out of total 10,89,445 candidates trained under DDU-GKY, 5,10,695 (46.87%) are women.
