457. SHRI KALYAN BANERJEE:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE & FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that share of agriculture and allied sectors in gross value added (GVA) of India at current prices dropped at 17.8 % in FY 2020 and has further dropped over another 1.5% in June 2021;
- (b) if so, the gross value added by agriculture and allied agri sectors was 283.68 US dollar billion and has dropped to 267 US\$ billion in FY 2019 and stood below 260 US\$ billion in 2020-21 therefor; and
- (c) if so, action taken or proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c): As per Provisional Estimates of Annual National Income, released by National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) on 31<sup>st</sup>, May 2021, the share of Agriculture and Allied Sectors in total Gross Value Added (GVA) of the country has increased from 18.4% in 2019-20 to 20.2% in 2020-21 at current prices.

The Gross Value Added of Agriculture and Allied Sectors at current price has increased from 33.94 lakh crore in 2019-20 to 36.16 lakh crore in 2020-21.
