457. SHRI KALYAN BANERJEE:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE & FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that share of agriculture and allied sectors in gross value added (GVA) of India at current prices dropped at 17.8 % in FY 2020 and has further dropped over another 1.5% in June 2021;

(b) if so, the gross value added by agriculture and allied agri sectors was 283.68 US doller billion and has dropped to 267 US\$ billion in FY 2019 and stood below 260 US\$ billion in 2020-21 therefor; and

(c) if so, action taken or proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): As per Provisional Estimates of Annual National Income, released by National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) on 31st, May 2021, the share of Agriculture and Allied Sectors in total Gross Value Added (GVA) of the country has increased from 18.4% in 2019-20 to 20.2% in 2020-21 at current prices.

The Gross Value Added of Agriculture and Allied Sectors at current price has increased from 33.94 lakh crore in 2019-20 to 36.16 lakh crore in 2020-21.
