Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) is issuing tenders for Round-the-Clock (RTC) green power of coal combined renewable energy rather than natural gas combined renewable energy;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government proposes any holistic green transition strategy to focus on green power; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b) Solar Energy Corporation of India Limited (SECI) has issued a tender for supply of Round-The-Clock (RTC) power from grid-connected renewable power projects complemented with power from any other source or storage. Power from any other source refers to power from any Power Generating Systems other than Renewable Power.

(c) & (d) Government had set up a target for installed renewable power generation capacity of 175 GW by the year 2022 and has also issued a year wise trajectory for Renewable Purchase Obligation (RPO) to facilitate transition to Green Power.

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
