## SETTING UP NEW GREENFIELD AIRPORTS IN THE COUNTRY

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION नागर विमानन मंत्री

be pleased to state:-

- (a) Whether the Government has received new proposals for setting up of new greenfield airports in the country;
- (b) if so, the details of such proposals received and the NOC given by the Government during the last three years and the current year, year and State-wise;
- (c) whether there is a proposal from the State of Kerala for setting up a Greenfield airport in Pathanamthitta Parliamentary Constituency; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

#### ANSWER

- (a) & (b): During the last three years and the current year, the Government of India has received proposals for setting up of new greenfield airports at Mandi in Himachal Pradesh, Kasargod and Kottayam in Kerala, Pantnagar in Uttarakhand and Purandar (Pune) in Maharashtra under the Greenfield Airports Policy. "In-Principle" and "Site Clearance" approval given by the Government during the last three years and the current year under the Greenfield Airports Policy is at Annexure.
- (c) & (d): No proposal has been received for development of an airport in Pathanamthitta District, Kerala from the State Government. However, Kerala State Industrial Development Corporation (KSIDC) has submitted a proposal for grant of 'site clearance' approval for setting up of Greenfield Airport at Kottayam in Kerala.
