WATER QUALITY IN DELHI

615. SHRI FEROZE VARUN GANDHI:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government or BIS has conducted any study of the water quality of Delhi; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with its major findings including the level of Uranium in water?

ANSWER

(a) The Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), an organization under the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, carried out a study of piped drinking water quality in capital cities including Delhi and cities selected for the smart cities project across India, from September, 2019 to March, 2020.

(b) Out of 11 samples drawn from various locations in Delhi, all of them were non-conforming in one or more of the parameters. Samples collected were not tested for Uranium contamination.
