Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

(a) the details of AYUSH medical colleges/ universities/institutes/hospitals/AYUSH Health and wellness centers including integrated hospitals along with the total number of graduate/post-graduate level seats which are functional and which are upcoming under National AYUSH Mission (NAM) across the country, State/UT-wise, district-wise and stream-wise particularly Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and Maharashtra;

(b) the total funds allocated/utilised for AYUSH medical colleges/universities/institutes/hospitals/wellness centers in the last three years, State/UT-wise/district wise/ stream-wise;

(c) the details of the steps being taken by the Government for better access and promotion of AYUSH services in the country including research works in post-graduate AYUSH colleges, adequate publicity through media, allocation of special funds for promotion etc; State/UT-wise/stream-wise;

(d) whether any criteria have been fixed for establishing new AYUSH institutions in the private sector and if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the details of AYUSH medical colleges/ universities/institutes/hospitals/ AYUSH Health and wellness centers etc. which have been derecognized, State/UT-wise, district-wise, stream-wise and the reasons for derecognition therefor?

(a): 738 Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani, Sowa Rigpa and Homoeopathy Medical Colleges, 3781 Ayush hospitals, 4,448 Ayush Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs) are available across the country including in the States of Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and Maharashtra. The details are at **Annexure -I.**

(b): State/UT wise status of funds allocated and utilised under National AYUSH Mission for various activities including for AYUSH medical colleges/universities/institutes/ hospitals / wellness centers during the last three years is furnished at **Annexure- II**.

(c): The details of steps taken by the Government for better access and promotion of AYUSH services in the country including research works in post-graduate AYUSH colleges, adequate publicity through media etc. is furnished at **Annexure-III**.

(d): The regulation 13A of Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970, provides for applying to the Central Government for establishing new Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani & Sow-Rigpa colleges including in the private sector. Further, the criteria for establishing new AYUSH institutions is prescribed under the Establishment of New Homoeopathy Medical College, (Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission capacity by a Medical college) Regulations, 2011.

(e): There are no de-recognized colleges in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Sowa Rigpa. However, Central Council of Indian Medicine (CCIM) had recommended 14 colleges (13 Ayurveda and 01 Unani) for de-recognition and the Ministry of Ayush has taken up the process of de-recognition with respective State Governments/Universities. The list of such 14 colleges is furnished at **Annexure IV**. Further, a list of derecognized Homoeopathy colleges is also furnished at **Annexure-IV**. These Homoeopathy colleges could not maintain the standards prescribed under the HCC Act, 1973.

The steps taken by the Government for better access and promotion of AYUSH services in the country including research works in post-graduate AYUSH colleges, adequate publicity through media etc.

The Central Government has launched the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) for the overall promotion of AYUSH including Ayurvedic treatment in the country. The Mission envisages better access to AYUSH services strengthening AYUSH educational institutions, in the States/UTs. In addition Union Cabinet also approved operationalization of the 12,500 AYUSH Health and Wellness Centres components under AYUSHMAN BHARAT for implementation through National AYUSH Mission for a period up to 2023-24. This component aims to provide a holistic wellness model based on AYUSH principles and practices to empower masses for “self-care” to reduce the disease burden, and out of pocket expenditure.

Further, the Ministry has taken up initiatives for propagating and promoting AYUSH systems of medicine including Ayurveda by organizing Arogya Fairs/Melas, Conferences, Exhibitions, Seminars, Workshops, Symposium and also publicity through electronic and print media. The Ministry is also observing important days dedicated to AYUSH Systems of Medicine viz. International Day of Yoga, Ayurveda Day, Unani Day, Siddha Day, Naturopathy Day and Homoeopathy Day etc. to create awareness about the benefits of AYUSH systems of medicine.
