### FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT

#### 725. DR. MANOJ RAJORIA:

Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- a) The details of present Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) limit in different channels of communication like television, news channels and FM radio etc. in the country;
- b) Whether the Government is contemplating any changes regarding FDI policy so as to improve quality and standards of different channels of communications to international level; and
- c) If so, the details thereof?

## **ANSWER**

(a) to (c): Under the extant FDI policy of the Government of India, the FDI limit for newspapers is 26%, for satellite news channels and FM radio it is 49%, while for non-news channels, FDI upto 100% is permissible. At present, there is no proposal to change these limits.
