(a) to (c): Handloom weaving societies in Chhattisgarh are in Janjgir-Champa, Ambikapur, Jashpur, Surajpur, Bilaspur, Mungeli, Korba, Raigarh, Raipur, Dhamtari, Gariaband, Mahasamund, Baloda Bazar, Durg, Bemetara, Rajnandgaon, Kabirdham (Kawardha), Balod, Jagdalpur (Bastar), Kondagaon, Kanker and Sukma.

The Government of India, Ministry of Textiles is implementing following schemes for overall development & promotion of handlooms and welfare of handloom weavers across the country including in the State of Chhattisgarh: -

- 1) National Handloom Development Programme (NHDP)
- 2) Comprehensive Handloom Cluster Development Scheme (CHCDS)
- 3) Handloom Weavers' Comprehensive Welfare Scheme (HWCWS)
- 4) Yarn Supply Scheme (YSS)

Under the above schemes, financial assistance is provided for raw materials, purchase of looms and accessories, design innovation, product diversification, infrastructure development, skill upgradation, lighting units, marketing of handloom products, getting loans at concessional rates, etc.

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
