MODERNIZATION OF BROADCASTING INFRASTRUCTURE

- (a) whether the Government has allocated funds amounting to Rs. 473 crores to Broadcasting Infrastructure Network Development (BIND) Scheme for modernization of broadcasting network infrastructure during the financial year 2019-20; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and present status of progress made in this regard?

(a) & (b): Yes Sir. Rs.473.00 crore was allocated to Prasar Bharati in 2019-20 at BE (Budget Estimate) stage under the "Broadcasting Infrastructure and Network Development (BIND)" scheme.

The various components of the scheme are as under:

- i. Modernization (including Digitization), Augmentation &
 Replacement of Transmitters
- ii. Modernization, Augmentation & Replacement of Satellite

 Broadcast equipment
- iii. Modernization & Digitalization of Studios
- iv. FM Expansion/Replacement (AIR)
- v. Expansion of DTH
- vi. Strengthening of Coverage in Sensitive areas by AIR
- vii. High Definition TV (HDTV)
- viii. Expansion of TV Channels
 - ix. Broadcasting on Alternate Platform
 - x. Augmentation of Civil Infrastructure including Staff Quarters and other misc. works
 - xi. E-governance project by AIR
- xii. Content Development and SAP (Swachhata Action Plan)

The allocation of the funds is made in a phased manner. The allocation of funds in the year 2019-20 and expenditure as under:
