SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRES IN NORTH EASTERN REGION

†87. SHRI DILIP SAIKIA:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of proposals for opening of skill development centres received by the Government from the North-Eastern States including Assam during the last two years;
- (b) if so, the number of such proposal accepted during the current financial year along with the funds relased thereof; and
- (c) the details of the proposals received from Assam, district-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

(a) to (c) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) promotes establishment of model and aspirational skill development centres known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKK) in every district of the country. During the last two financial years (2019 – 20 and 2020-21), 123 proposals were received out of which 30 proposals were accepted from North East states of India. Since the concerned PMKKs were self-funded, no funds were released from MSDE in the North East States of India during the last two financial years (2019 -20, 2020-21). No proposals were received from the State of Assam during the last two financial years.
