- (c) whether the private school teachers experienced loss of income due to job loss or salary cuts since the first case of covid-19 in the country and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (d) the details of steps taken to address it along with the role of States in addressing it and if the States have no role, the reasons therefor;
- (e) whether any study has been conducted on the impact of COVID-19 on incomes of private school teachers, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (f) the details of teachers and non-teaching staff, working in Government & private unaided schools, who have received coronavirus vaccine since 2020-21, Statewise?

(a) :The number of teachers in Government Schools in primary & Secondary Classes since 2018-19, state & years wise is enclosed as Annexure-A.

(b) to (e) : Education is a concurrent subject under the Constitution of India, and majority of the schools come under the purview of State and UT Governments. The recruitment and other service matters of teachers are under the domain of State/UT Governments. Salary structure is determined based on norms of the State/UT. The salary disbursed by the State to the teachers may vary depending on the State guidelines.
