**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (b) OF THE STARRED QUESTION NO.143 DUE FOR ANSWER ON 08.12.2021 IN THE LOK SABHA.**

**(a)&(b): Significant improvement in nutritional status has been made in nutritional outcomes including that at state level. The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare is conducting one integrated survey namely National Family Health Survey (NFHS) to generate data on important demographic, health and nutritional indicators. However, no direct assessment has been made to study the impact of Food Security Schemes.
